April 25th, 2010 Sunday **China Hat ISDE** Bend, Oregon

*OMRA Points Points Event.

This approx 80 mile timed event is a reliability Enduro, a meet designed to measure the reliability of the machine and the skill of the rider involved during the time of the event. The rules of participation will be the same as the AMA/FIM rules used in Enduro competition. The rules governing this type of event favor the "GO FAST" attitude. The timing or speed average established for each section, check to check, is a measurement of the riders ability to cover the distance as prescribed. (Averages will vary depending on the terrain challenges of the route). You do not need a speedometer or a watch. The special test sections are very important, as they will measure your riding capabilities and are a determining factor in who the winner is.

May 15th, 2010 Sunday **"Dirty Daves" Poker Run** (Diamond Mill)

A non-competitive type event. Riders will ride a designated course, either a hard course or an easy course, which has been laid out by the club consisting of checkpoints along the way. There will be either live check points or dead check points. You must have all your checks when you finish the run. Courses are usually marked with ribbon or arrows. Poker runs are a family, non-competitive event and a fun way to ride in a new area without getting lost. Plus meet people with the same interests.

June 19th and 20th, 2010 Saturday & Sunday China Hat Bend, Oregon

China Hat National 2 day Dual Sport

Part of the Dual-sport Series that allows riders to accumulate points in a non competitive way. You **MUST** be an OMRA member at the time of the event (either current or have signed up) to be awarded points for this event. These points are then totaled up and at the end of the year banquet, you are then eligible to win one of the year end trophies and bragging rights. Riders will ride a designated course, either a hard course or an easy course, (or a combination of both) which has been laid out by the club. There will be check points, often with games of chance where you will receive points. At the end of the ride each rider's points are then totaled, the highest point total is the winner, similar to a poker run. Course directions are usually indicated by an Enduro roll chart or route sheet that the riders must follow. Bikes must be street legal and properly muffled.

August 29th, 2010 Sunday **"Tennis shoe" Dual Sport Ride** (Location Oregon City)

*OMRA Sanctioned Dual Sport points event

Same as above but a one day event.

October 23rd & 24th, 2010 Saturday & Sunday China Hat Bend, Oregon

2 Day Fall Classic X-Country Desert Race.

*Both days are OMRA Points events.

This X-Country Desert Race consists of no less than 70 total ground miles each day. We will use the Banner-Drop System, when it is raised, shut off your engine, and when it falls, GO! The race is over at the checkered flag and the first rider through (per class) is the winner for that day, second rider is second place and so on. The two days score will be combined.
